4. **Resource Requirements Analysis** - List what you need to complete the project.

5. **Partner Organization Collaboration Plan** - Work with other groups for support.
6. **Student Learning Outcomes Definition** - Explain what students will learn.
7. **Budget Proposal Creation** - Plan how to spend money for the project.
8. **Risk Assessment Protocol** - Think about problems that might come up.
9. **Marketing and Outreach Strategy** - Plan how to tell people about the project.
10. **Volunteer Management Structure** - Organize and guide helpers.
11. **Data Collection Methods** - Decide how to gather information.
12. **Impact Measurement Tools** - Figure out how to see if the project was successful.
